Numbers: review 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

Introduction: 9

Action verbs: look, find, listen, say, match, trace, color, draw, stick, jump, walk, paint, clean, can, throw, catch, scream, run, stop, show me, give me, put, cook.

Thursday 12th Letters and numbers workbook page 68. The children trace the "s" shape with their index finger first, and then with different colored crayon several times. Finally, they color in the pictures freely.

Thursday 19th Letters and numbers workbook page 70. Trace the "s" shape with different colored crayons. Identify the food

Thursday 27th Letters and numbers workbook page 71. Count the number of slices in each cake aloud, then match the cake with the corresponding number. Trace the numbers and color freely.
